

Improvement works – Tubbs Bottom Washland

The Environment Agency will be carrying out statutory improvement works

- Works are planned to take place **between July and early September 2026**.
- Contractors' personnel and machinery will be working in the Washland area and adjacent fields.
- Contractors will be transporting equipment and materials to/from the A432 Badminton Road **via Frampton End Road and Tubbs Bottom**.
- The left bank of the Reservoir will be enhanced to prevent surface erosion that complies with dam safety and regulatory requirements.
- Regular maintenance task will also take place in the location during the summer months.
